Sara L. Drew and Karen Fritschel came to the Stow Police Department today to file an informational report regarding a conflict which occurred at approx. 1145 hours today in the 3600 Block of Adaline Drive. Ms. Drew stated that she received a phone call today from a resident of Adaline Drive. The caller reported to Ms. Drew that there were people on Adaline Drive who were going door-to-door and were making inaccurate statements about Ms. Drew and another candidate for political office in the City of Stow. Ms. Drew stated that there was some concern that the statements and/or literature being disseminated by the people on Adaline Drive might be in violation of campaign rules, so she went to Adaline Drive (the street on which she resides) to investigate. Karen Fritschel had also received similar information from a citizen, and arrived on Adaline Drive at approx. the same time Ms. Drew arrived.

Ms. Drew reports that she and Fritschel observed Stow citizen Mary Mumper and an unidentified male carrying what appeared to be political literature. They asked Mumper what she was distributing. Mumper told Drew and Fritschel that she was passing out literature for three political candidates. Mumper reportedly told Fritschel that she (Fritschel) is "evil and corrupt". Fritschel had a brief conversation with Mumper regarding campaign violations and the Secretary of State. Ms. Drew states that she attempted to calm Mumper, but Mumper began telling her (Drew) that she is also "evil". Drew reports that she attempted to end the conversation by walking away and saying "have a good day Mrs. Mumper". Mumper reportedly began closely following Ms. Drew as she walked away and shouting at her. This continued until Ms. Drew reached the door of a friend's house on Adaline Drive. At that time, Mumper walked away, still continuing to shout at her.

Ms. Drew stated that she wanted to file this report for documentation of the incident. She is also concerned that Mumper might report this incident inaccurately to the Police or to any other third parties. I advised Ms. Drew that I would include the written statement she provided with this report. Mrs. Fritschel stated that she will report any violation of campaign rules to the Ohio Attorney General's Office.

This case is closed, as there were no allegations of criminal behavior made and the report was filed for documentation purposes only.

I received a phone call saying that a man was walking down Adaline Drive handing out literature and stating to residents that if I and John Tribonic were elected on November 8, we were planning on "circumventing the law and making the city come to houses to do inspections of private homes on the inside". This man was also saying residents would have their property values re-assessed by the city as part of this alleged inspection program.

I was not at home when I saw this call (I live on Adaline Drive) so I drove to my street. Karen Fritschel met me there and when I arrived she was walking toward this man and a woman I know (Mary Mumper). When asked what they were passing out Mrs. Mumper showed flyers for 3 political candidates. The man clutched his bag, said "I don't have to show you" and hurried down the street. Mrs. Mumper then started yelling at Karen Fritschel and telling her she was "evil" and "corrupt". I said no one was evil here and no one was corrupt. Mrs. Mumper and Karen Fritschel had a brief conversation about campaign violations and the Secretary of State. Mrs. Mumper again said I was evil and so was Mrs. Fritschel. I said "have a good day, Mrs. Mumper" and started to walk down the sidewalk. Mrs. Mumper followed me yelling that I was evil and should be investigated. I repeated several times "have a good day, Mrs. Mumper" and kept walking. She continued to follow me until I went up to a door of a friend's house who lives on the street. Mrs. Mumper shouted at me as she walked away toward Holy Family church.

NARRATIVE:

On November 1, 2011 at approximately noon, Beale and Mumper were handing out campaign material in the area of 3420 Adaline Drive. Beale states that Mayor Fritschel stopped her car and approached them. Beale stated that Fritschel used a raised voice when confronting them and stated that they were spreading misleading and incorrect information. Beale stated that Fritschel did not cite any specific examples of what was incorrect or misleading.

Beale stated that Fritschel demanded to look at the material that he and Mumper were handing out. Beale stated he provided the Mayor with the campaign material that they were handing out for various candidates. Beale stated that Fritschel threatened to follow up with the election officials to seek charges for handing out improper campaign material.



MINI REPORT - Continued

After providing Fritschel with the campaign material, Beale walked off to avoid further conversation. While Beale was away from Mumper and Fritschel, Sara Drew approached on foot and spoke to Mumper as well. Beale is unsure what the content of that conversation was.

Beale stated that due to being a former law enforcement officer, he was not intimidated during the conversation. However, Beale feels that Mumper was made to be upset by the contact with Fritschel.

I asked Beale if charges were made available, would he want to have charges. He stated at this point, he would prefer that Fritschel cease confronting and challenging them any further while handing out campaign materials. I informed Beale that based on the information that he provided, I didn't feel that any laws were broken and that no charges would be available.

During the conversation, I confirmed with Beale that at no time did Fritschel swear and at no time were any threats made other than to follow up with election officials.

After speaking with Beale, I contacted Mary Mumper by phone. Mumper declined the opportunity to speak with me about the incident by phone. Mumper stated that she desired to explain the incident with an attorney present as well as Police Chief Dirker.

Due to the lack of an applicable criminal charge, based on Beale's account of the event and Mumper declining to speak with me about the incident, I will not be checking into the incident further or contacting any of the other parties involved.
